Agreements

- Common educational goal: Improvement of the ability of staying in groups (to be a part of, enjoying, working...) or premising abilities (self-efficacy, development of self-confidence)
- each class plans and realises an activity
- partner-classes: classes exchange activities

Q3 – How do you feel about the project now? Did you get more energy and motivation? Was it a heavier workload? (If yes, why? Are there any changes possible for the next theme?)

Observations

- Evaluation of experiences: basically positive
- Pupils showed improved performance in social and curricular skills
- High motivation
- More self-efficacy (->proud)
- Development of the community spirit

Feelings

- Heavier workload because of
 - additional work (no replacement of other work)
 - new structure of planning and teaching (less routine)
- Higher motivation because of
 - feeling of enrichment
 - change of role: from leader teacher to companion teacher

Ideas for improvement

- Higher implementation into the curriculum
 - > replacing work instead of additional work
- More cooperation with external organisations
 - > activities outside school
- Common activities of different classes
