

Flight: Group Tasks

Group 1: Blyth/Plessey: gym: What goes up? (throwing, jumping, climbing, wind power, Autumnal explorations/balloons, ets)

- Loose PE parts (climbing and balancing)
- Parachute/lycra (with props)
- Balloons/string/bucket/pulley/etc

Group 2: Blagdon/Druridge: garden: What do bees do? (exploring the importance and features of bees and other winged insects)

- Rope and glue (make a rope beehive)
- Binliners and yellow tape (bee bodies)
- Black card and yellow pompoms (turn yourself into a bee)

Group 3: Newbiggin/new class: garden: what is a bird? (finding out about feathers and flight, birds of prey and others)

- Triangular card, tape, string, paper, feathers (make wings)
- Assorted sticks, wool, etc – (make a nest)
- Fat, seeds, cups, string – (make a bird feeder)

Group 4: Woodhorn/Amble: Can we be heroes? (Superheroes – what qualities do we need to succeed?)

- Fabric, mask shapes, pritt, card, pens (design a costume)
- Superhero passports
- Split-pin superheroes

Group 5: Rothbury/Hexham/Bamburgh: How can I defy gravity? (STEAM focus; flying machines – from Leonardo Da Vinci's designs to now and the future)

- 1 piece of paper, no instructions
- 1 with instructions
- Props to invent a flying machine

Each group will also be given talking tins/speech bubbles to create audio effects.

15 minutes to create something to communicate their flight focus to the other groups.
