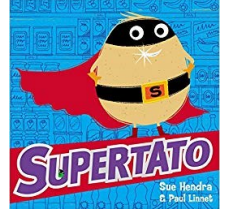




Theme: What makes a superhero?

Personal, Social, Emotional Development:

- Work on ideas around friendships and how to sustain friendships.
- To recognise good choices
- Develop Teamwork skills
- Recognise feelings and emotions.
- Introduction and practice relaxation and self-soothing techniques.
- Agree on class rules



Language and Literacy:

- X3 Read Write Inc lessons per week - children will be working within ability groups.
- X1 creative literacy lesson per week – Power of Reading approach – Supertato book set.
- Regular one to one reading with an adult using their pupil reading book.

Computing:

- Computer Safety
- Coding
- Exploring old present and new technology used.
- Researching skills and strategies

Humanities:

- Our class topic is 'Superheroes' and we will be exploring both fictional and nonfictional heroes.
- We will be working on Humanities projects that answer an enquiry question and combines skills from many different areas including: History, Geography, Music, Art, Creative Learning and RE.
- Here are some of the other topics and ideas we will be learning about:

 - Halloween
 - Guy Fawkes
 - Christmas

Physical Development:

- PE will take place every Monday afternoon:
- Autumn Term 1 – Dodgeball
- Autumn Term 2 – Hockey
- Swimming lessons will take place every Tuesday afternoon. Each week, please provide your child with a swimming kit and a towel.
- Rebound Therapy
- Children may also receive weekly Rebound Therapy sessions. Parent consent form needed.

- Classes will have the opportunity to use the schools outdoor spaces including the Active Zone, sensory room, soft play room, garden and park.

Art and CDT:

- Year 6 pupils will participate in The Bronze arts award. This award will be taught throughout the year.
- Our autumn art and CDT learning will be linked to our superheroes topic. We shall explore different artists focusing on drawing and shading. We shall also be designing our very own superhero costumes including capes and masks.

Science:

- Children will have opportunities to work on STEM projects to develop their Science, Engineering, Technology, (including ICT), and Maths skills. They will also have weekly Science lessons.
