
Idea: Creating different boxes for diversified leisure activities


Aim: Supporting autistic pupils in finding out their interests and becoming able to spend their leisure time in a more joyful and varied way,

- helping them to make a choice
- encourage them to try out new activities
- support them in getting orientation on their activities.

All boxes got a special label which contents information about:

- What is in the box?
- When am I allowed to take the box?
- Do I need necessarily the help of an adult?
- How many children are allowed to play with the boy at the same time?





All boxes content instructions how to deal with the things inside (if necessary).

Beside this main focus all boxes support children in developing different skills such as creativity, motorical development, concentration.
