Feedback and Evaluation Form – End of Whole Project

Q1 – How many teachers/non-teaching staff were involved in the project? How many pupils were affected by the project? Were other people (e.g. parents, external organisations etc.) involved in the project?

We were 7 seven teachers were involved and one headmaster. But only three teachers were directly involved. Appx 180 pupils were involved in the project.
Other people: the secretary at our school also helped us.

As we have to sites at Tarm school our student go from 6th grade which is situated at one site and the have to move up and into 7th grade at the other site, it is a very difficult time for some of the pupil with all new faces.

We would take a lot of the ideas and work to try to cooperate with the teachers between the sites so that we may ease the process of knowing more teachers at the new site.

And a very important point we have learned a lot about how to include pupil with different disabilities.

Our intention was not to include the entire school even though that was a big subject at this project, we will still not be able to do so.
